Job Summary: Fabricates, erects, installs, and repairs structures and fixtures of wood, plywood, wallboard, & all other such components related to the construction and completion of work aboard ships and shipyard facilities following blueprints, lay-out drawings, sketches, building plans, or oral instructions.

Essential Duties:

- 1.** Selects specified type of material to be used. Prepares layout, using rule, square, or whatever tool necessary.
- 2.** Forms up concrete is necessary.
- 3.** Marks cutting and assembly lines on materials, using pencil, chalk, or marking instrument.
- 4.** Shapes materials to prescribed measurements.
- 5.** Assembles cut and shaped materials and fastens them together using nails, screws, dowel pins, and glue.
- 6.** Erects framework for structures and lays subflooring.
- 7.** Builds stairs and lays out and installs partitions.
- 8.** Installs insulation in walls, ceilings, and floors.
- 9.** Fits and installs prefabricated window frames, door frames, doors, interior and exterior panels and trim, weather stripping, and all other finish hardware, such as locks, hinges, knobs, and vents.
- 10.** Builds, repairs, and installs counters, cabinets, benches, tables, and all other components associated with the finish work on vessels, using hand tools and power tools.
- 11.** Follow company policies/ procedures and observe safety and security procedures.
- 12.** Performs incidental tasks such as transporting tools, materials, and supplies. May use overhead cranes. May also operate company vehicles.
